A Video Workshop on Vaginal Surgery and Urogynaecology was conducted on 18th October 2015 at SantParmanand Hospital, Civil lines, New Delhi to mark the "World Menopause Day". The Workshop was conducted under the aegis of Royal College of Obstetricians & Gynaecologists (RCOG-NZ), Indian Menopause Society (IMS), and NARCHI Delhi chapter. It was a comprehensive workshop with lectures by national level faculty, video sessions, panel discussions and OSCE station. Apart from 27 faculty members there were 69 delegates and the workshop was well attended by practitioners as well as PG students. Topics covered included anatomy of female pelvis, urodynamics principles, management of incontinence and video sessions on female cystoscopy, vaginal surgeries for pelvic organ prolapse and stress incontinence, urethroplasty, abdominal sacral colpopexy and hysteropexy to mention a few. The audience response was excellent and there were many interesting discussions. All the delegates received a kitbag with a Handbook on Vaginal Surgery and Urogynaecology and were required to fill a feedback form at the end of the session. To summarize, the workshop was extremely interactive and fruitful and we look forward to conducting similar workshops in the near future.
